Associate Professor Dr. Vera Bushati is an architect and a member of Adriapol, as well as the coordinator of Open Forums at Barleti University. In 1969, she graduated from the Faculty of Civil Engineering at the University of Tirana (now UPT), in the field of architecture and construction, with an "excellent" diploma. Her professional career began at the construction company "Lushnje," initially as an engineer and later as chief engineer, a position she held until 1974.

She then continued her academic career at the University of Tirana, where she worked as a lecturer in the subjects of Construction Technology and the History of Architecture and Urbanism, from 1974 to 1992.

In addition to teaching, Associate Professor Dr. Vera Bushati has given lectures on the History of Albanian Architecture at several foreign universities, including the University of Prishtina, Stockholm, Marburg, and the Vienna University of Technology.

She has also practiced as an architect and construction engineer in other countries outside of Albania, including Lebanon and Congo. In 1982, she successfully completed her doctoral thesis focused on Illyrian housing architecture, and she is currently a lecturer at Barleti University.
